Module 2: Wage and Tip Income

Wage and salary income is compensation received by employees for services performed.

<u>Tips</u> are money and goods received by food servers, baggage handlers, hairdressers, and others as a gratuity for services performed.

Employers report wage, salary, and tip income on Form W-2, Wage and Tax Statement.

Employees use Form W-2 to complete their individual income tax returns.
